**COACHES:**

**CLINT CONQUE** is in his 10th season at the helm of the UCA football program. He has a 73-39-0 overall record, including an 10-2 mark last season.

Conque, who came to UCA from Louisiana Tech in 2000, led the Bears to their first-ever NCAA Playoff appearance in 2001. UCA finished 9-3 that season, the most wins in a year since the 1992 season. He took them back to the playoffs in 2005, winning two straight road games and advancing to the national quarterfinals.



His Bears finished the 2008 season with the best record in the Southland Conference at 6-1 but were ineligible for the league title due to their transition. Conque was named the SLC Coach of the Year last season.

Conque, 48, is a Louisiana native who played collegiately at Nicholls State after graduating from Catholic High School in Baton Rouge and playing two years at Southwest Mississippi Junior College.

Conque was a first-team AP All-American as a outside linebacker at Nicholls State. He was inducted into the Nicholls State Athletic Hall of Fame in 2006.

His previous coaching stops were at Louisiana Tech, Samford University and McNeese State.

**BRAD WRIGHT** is in his third season as the head coach of the Bobcats, with an overall record of 17-15. He led the Bobcats to a 5-2 conference record in 2008, trailing only UCA.

Wright was a walk-on at Southwest Texas State in the late 1970s and ended up starting two years at free safety on a Lone Star Conference championship team.

He earned his degree in 1981 and began his coaching career at the school under Jim Wacker. He also coached at Louisiana-Lafayette and at several high schools in Texas.

Wright joined the Texas State staff in 2004 as assistant head coach, running backs coach and special teams coordinator, then took over as head coach in the Spring of 2007, his first collegiate head coaching job.

## THE SERIES:

This will be just the third meeting between the Bears and Bobcats, with UCA leading the series 2-0.

The Bears won the initial meeting in 2007, 63-21 in Conway, in a game also televised on SLC TV. UCA won 31-24 last year at Bobcat Stadium in San Marcos.

## CONQUE CLIMBING:

Bears head coach Clint Conque, in his 10th season, has won 73 games at UCA, which places him second all-time at the school in career victories. He is only the second coach in school history to achieve the 70-victory plateau.

He now trails only UCA Sports Hall of Famer Harold Horton, who had a phenomenal 74-12-5 record from 1982-89.

## NATIONAL RANKINGS:

UCA dropped a couple of spots in the Coaches FCS Poll, from 12th to 19th. The Bears also fell from 15th to 20th in The Sports Network poll.

UCA reached a high of 8th in the nation last month, the best regular-season ranking since moving to FCS in 2006.

The Bears were ranked anywhere from No. 8 to No. 16 in the various FCS preseason polls this fall.

The Bears were ranked as high as No. 9 in the nation during the 2008 season. They finished the season No. 12 in both polls.

## LAST YEAR:

The Bears got a then career-high 132 yards rushing from Brent Grimes to down the Bobcats 31-24 at San Marcos.

UCA rushed for a season-high 231 yards, including 59 from Leonard Ceaser, and controlled the ball for 37:02. UCA totaled 394 yards of offense and held TSU to 376.

The Bears led 14-0 before the Bobcats got on the scoreboard midway through the second quarter. UCA held a 21-14 lead at the half on Ceaser's 5-yard touchdown run, Willie Landers' 31-yard TD pass from Nathan Brown and a 1-yard run by Grimes.

After TSU cut the lead to 21-17 early in the fourth quarter, UCA put the game away with a 1-yard TD pass from Brown to fullback Nick Cowger and a 35-yard field goal from Eddie Carmona.

The Bobcats added one more touchdown in the final minute but UCA's Anthony Gambles recovered the onside kick to end it.

## LAST WEEK:

The Bears sputtered offensively with three interceptions and dropped a 25-21 decision to Southeastern University on the road in Hammond, La.

UCA fell behind 17-9 at halftime, its largest deficit of the season, but fought back to take the lead at 19-17 on Eddie Carmona's school-record fourth field goal of the game with 1:04 left in the third quarter.

But the Lions, who moved into a first-place tie with the victory, got a 16-yard touchdown pass from Tyler Beatty to Chris Wilson at the 8:18 mark of the fourth period to seal it.

UCA finished with 360 yards of offense, its second-lowest output of the season (270 at Hawaii). Senior Brent Grimes led all rushers with 83 yards and a touchdown, while Robbie Park completed 19 of 40 passes for 223 yards but was intercepted three times, all in the fourth quarter.

Senior Preston Echols caught four passes for 121 yards for the Bears. Senior linebacker James Lancaster had a team-high 9 tackles and a fumble recovery.

## SCORING MACHINE:

Senior tailback Brent Grimes led the Southland in scoring last season with a league-record 21 touchdowns and 126 points. The Baton Rouge native has picked up where he left off with 13 touchdowns in 8 games this season.

He is No. 2 in the Southland in scoring, averaging 9.8 points per game.

Grimes is currently tied for first on the all-time UCA list for touchdowns (53) and second in scoring (318 points). Former RB Kentrel Rogers holds both records with 53 TDs and 322 points.

Grimes tied the school record with 5 TDs against Stephen F. Austin last season. In that game, he had career highs of 36 carries and 145 yards, and also had a career-high 8 receptions in the Bears' 49-41 victory.

## L.B. JACKMAN AWARD:

Grimes was named the winner of the annual L.B. Jackman Award as outstanding player of the homecoming game. The award is voted on by the working media at the game.

It was Grimes' second time to win the award, to go along with his honor as a freshman. In that game, Grimes rushed 12 times for 116 yards and two touchdowns in UCA's 55-21 win over Southern Arkansas

He is only the fifth player to win the award more than once, joining Bobby Tiner (1963, 66, 67), Mike Painter (1975, 77), Phil Caldwell (1980, 81) and Ken Collums (1991, 94).

## KICKIN' IT:

Eddie Carmona has been perfect this season as a placekicker, and added two school records to his resume last week.

The Charleston kicker has made 11 of 11 field goal attempts and 29 of 29 extra points. His long field goal this season is 40 yards last week against Southeastern Louisiana.

His career long was a 47-yard field goal last year against McNeese State.

He now owns the school record with 13 consecutive field goals, surpassing UCA Sports Hall of Famer Curtis Burrow's old mark of nine. His four field goals last week also set a single-game

A year ago in his first season at UCA, Carmona was 13 of 19 on field goals and 53 of 57 on PATs.

### PLAYERS OF THE GAME:

The weekly "Player of the Game" awards, handed out by the UCA coaching staff, went to senior receiver Preston Echols on offense, senior safety Derrick Boyd on defense and junior kicker Eddie Carmona and senior punter Jon Beard on special teams. The "Big Stick" award went to senior linebacker James Lancaster.

### HOME LOSS:

The loss three weeks ago to SFA was the first at home for the Bears since they lost to South Dakota State on Nov. 3, 2007. It broke a 10-game home winning streak. It was UCA's first home conference loss since Valdosta State on Sept. 25, 2004.

### PLAYERS OF THE WEEK:

UCA has had six players named Southland Conference Player of the Week this year. The latest was last week when junior placekicker Eddie Carmona earned his second award of the year as Special Teams Player of the Week. The others were: Carmona against Northwestern State; senior safety Derrick Boyd against Missouri S&T; senior safety Pieri Feazell against Hawaii; senior quarterback Robbie Park and senior linebacker James Lancaster against Western Kentucky.

### BEHIND THE LINE:

The Bears have had 38 different players record at least one tackle this season. The amazing number is 27 different players have been in on a tackle for loss.

UCA has recorded 64 lost-yardage plays for a minus 236 yards. Included in that number is 18 sacks for minus 121 yards.

The leader in tackles for loss is junior defensive end Markell Carter with 8.5 (-45 yards). Senior linebacker Jacob Bane has 8 (-22). The sack leader is senior DE Larry Hart with 6 (-43) while Carter has 5.5 (-37).

UCA has recorded only four interceptions in seven games (Hart, James Lancaster, Pieri Feazell, Derrick Boyd).

UCA has also forced 15 turnovers in seven games (4 interceptions, 11 fumbles).

### NATIONAL FCS RANKINGS:

The Bears are tied for second in the nation in sacks allowed (5), 7th in kick returns (24.8), 8th in the nation in tackles for loss

(64), tied for 10th in red zone offense (87%), 11th in scoring defense (15.4), 19th in total offense (408.2) and 21st in punt returns (11.8).

Individuals ranked in the Top 10 include: Larry Hart tied for third in forced fumbles and tied for 21st in sacks; Brent Grimes tied for fourth in scoring, James Lancaster tied for fourth in fumble recoveries, Isaiah Jackson 16th in kick returns and Eddie Carmona 19th in field goals per game.

### vs. THE SOUTHLAND:

Since joining the Southland Conference in 2006, UCA has put together a stellar 15-5 record.

The lone losses have come to McNeese State and Northwestern State in 2007, Nicholls State last season, to SFA two weeks ago and to Southeastern last Saturday. Four of those five losses were on the road. UCA is 8-1 at home in Southland play.

### ADD GRIMES:

Grimes is just 48 receiving yards short of becoming the first player in UCA history to rush for more than 2,000 yards and catch passes for 1,000 yards.

He stands at 2,510 career rushing yards (9th in school history) and now has 952 receiving yards.

### UCA vs. FBS:

UCA, in its fourth season at the FCS (playoff) level, won its first game over an FBS school on Sept. 19, knocking off Western Kentucky 28-7 on the road in Bowling Green, Ky.

The Bears were 0-5 against FBS teams, including losses to Arkansas State in 1996 and 1997, to Louisiana Tech in 2007, to Tulsa in 2008 and to Hawaii in the 2009 season opener.

For the first time in school history, the Bears played two FBS teams in the same season and it just happened to be the first two games of the season.

### UCA VS. TEXAS:

In the Clint Conque era, the Bears have lost only once

to a school from Texas. The Bears are 11-1 since the 2000 season.

Under Conque, UCA has beaten Abilene Christian and Sam Houston State three times each, Stephen F. Austin and Texas State twice.

Prior to the SFA loss three weeks ago, the Bears had won 15 consecutive games against teams from Texas, dating back to the early 1990s. The last Texas school to beat UCA was East Texas State (now Texas A&M-Commerce) in 1993.

UCA's overall record against Texas schools is 22-9-1.

### TV TIME:

The Bears had their perfect television record over the past nine years broken in the season opener with the loss at Hawaii. Prior to that, UCA had won nine consecutive televised games, including wins over Sam Houston and McNeese State a year ago. During the Conque era, beginning in 2000, the Bears are now 9-2 in televised games after the loss to SFA.

UCA will return to TV this week when it hosts Texas State.

### REIGNING "CHAMPS":

The Bears "won" the Southland Conference title last season, at least on the field. UCA finished with a league-best 6-1 record, besting second-place Texas State (5-2) and McNeese State and Northwestern State, both at 4-3.

However, the Bears were not eligible to be named conference champions because of their transition, according to an NCAA ruling handed down with two weeks remaining in the season.

According to the NCAA, if the Southland were to allow UCA to be crowned league champion, the conference would lose its automatic qualifier for the playoffs.

UCA is in the fourth year of its four-year transition from NCAA Division II to Division I FCS and is ineligible for postseason play until 2010.

The title of conference champion and the automatic qualifier went to Texas State (5-2 in league play), which lost 31-13 to Montana in the first round of the playoffs.

The Bears' last official conference championship was won in 2005 at the NCAA Division II level when they took the Gulf South Conference championship.

### PARK PLACE:

Fifth-year senior Robbie Park, who took over this season for record-setting quarterback Nathan Brown, has been efficient in eight starts this season.

Park, who started three games over the course of his career when Brown was injured, has completed 143 of 223 passes (64.1 percent) for 1,765 yards. He has 12 touchdown passes and 6 interceptions and an efficiency rating of 142.99.

Against Western Kentucky, Park completed 18 of 21 passes,

with the other three passes dropped. Against Glenville State, he threw for a career-high 358 yards.

### IN THE RED:

The Bears are No. 1 in the Southland Conference in red-zone defense. UCA has allowed opponent scores on only 15 of 23 trips into the red zone (65.2 percent).

UCA also leads the league in scoring defense (15.4), kickoff returns (24.8), kickoff coverage (44.1), field goals (1.000), sacks against (0.62), opponent first downs (16.2) and opponent third down conversions (30.4).

### HOME RECORD:

Over the past five seasons, the Bears are 27-4 at home at First Security Field at Estes Stadium, including 7-0 last season.

The lone losses were to South Dakota State in 2007, North Alabama in the NCAA Division II playoff quarterfinals in 2005, to Valdosta State in 2004 and to SFA this season.

UCA went 4-1 in 2007 at Estes, was 4-0 in 2006, went 5-1 in 2005 (5-0 in the regular season) and had a 4-1 mark in 2004.

The Bears are 3-1 at home this season.

### ESTES CROWDS:

The Bears have played to record crowds in recent years at First Security Field at Estes Stadium. Four of UCA's Top 10 home crowds of all time came last season.

UCA drew 12,313 for the Sam Houston State game (2nd ranked), 12,158 for the Henderson State game (3rd), 10,873 for the Quincy game (5th) and 10,220 for the McNeese State game (10th).

The largest crowd in school history was 12,620 vs. Nicholls State on Nov. 3, 2007.

This year's homecoming crowd of 10,653 was the ninth largest in history. The Missouri S&T game on Oct. 3 drew 10,443, the 10th largest crowd in school history. UCA students were on fall break against SFA and the game drew 7,527 fans.

### AWARD WINNERS:

UCA captured three of the six postseason individual awards handed out by the Southland Conference last fall.

Head Coach Clint Conque was the SLC Coach of the Year, while senior quarterback Nathan Brown was the SLC Player of the Year.

The SLC Defensive Player of the Year award went to UCA junior defensive end Larry Hart, who returns for his senior season as a much-decorated All-American.

The Bears had seven first-team All-SLC selections a year ago, six second-teamers and three honorable mentions.

### HALL OF FAME:

UCA inducted 10 new members into its Sports Hall of Fame last month, including Charlie Strong, University of Florida defensive coordinator/associate head coach for the No. 1 Florida Gators. Strong played defensive back at UCA from 1978-81.

### MISSING IN ACTION:

The Bears are missing two of those All-SLC players. Junior receiver Willie Landers injured a knee on the first day of practice in

August and had ACL surgery. Senior fullback Nick Cowger injured his knee before the opener and will also miss the 2009 season.

### **WINNING WAYS:**

UCA entered the 2009 season as the winningest college football team in the state of Arkansas since 2001.

Their best outing was an 11-3 record back in 2005 when they reached the quarterfinal round of the NCAA Division II Playoffs and tied the school record for victories.

### **NEW FACES:**

The UCA coaching staff has a couple of new faces this season, along with a couple of familiar faces taking on new duties.

Both coordinators are new in defensive coordinator Matt Williamson and offensive coordinator Brooks Hollingsworth. Williams was the Bears' defensive tackles coach a year ago, while the veteran Hollingsworth was offensive line coach and recruiting coordinator. Head coach Clint Conque will return to his roots as play caller on game day.

Conque also hired Buster Faulkner as quarterbacks coach, Dan Augustine as defensive line/special teams coordinator. Adam Federle is the new interior defensive line/recruiting coordinator and Jerry Mack is now receivers/passing game coordinator.

### **SOUTHLAND TV:**

SLC TV is back this year with 11 live football broadcasts, along with 16 basketball games, and championships of the soccer, volleyball, softball and baseball tournaments.

UCA's home games with Stephen F. Austin (Oct. 17) and Texas State (Nov. 7) will be broadcast live from First Security Field at Estes Stadium.

The affiliates showing the SLC package include: KARZ in Little Rock, KFDM television and Time Warner Cable in Beaumont, TX, KTBU in Houston, WBTR in Baton Rouge, La., KPXJ in Shreveport, La., KWCE in Alexandria, La., KVHP in Lake Charles, La., and MYTX in Tyler, Texas.

### **SLC TELECONFERENCE:**

The Southland Conference hosts a weekly teleconference with the football coaches at 10:30 a.m. each Tuesday.

Coach Clint Conque is the first coach to take questions each week, beginning at approximately 10:35. Todd Lamb of the SLC recaps the weekly highlights and previews the upcoming games beginning at 10:30. The teleconferences will run on [www.ucasports.com](http://www.ucasports.com) as well as on [www.southland.org](http://www.southland.org).

### **DIRTY DOZEN:**

The Bears will be the only FCS team to play 12 regular-season games this season, because of the trip to Hawaii.

UCA played 12 regular-season games for the first time ever a year ago and will now face a dozen opponents for the second

straight year. Beginning last Saturday, the Bears will play on 11 consecutive weekends with no break.

### **GOTTA HAVE HART:**

Senior defensive end Larry Hart was an All-American a year ago, as well as the Southland Defensive Player of the Year. He finished seventh in the voting for the 2008 Buck Buchanan Award that goes to the nation's top FCS defensive player. He is on the 2009 watch list for the award.

Hart, who transferred in last year from Holmes Community college, led the Southland in sacks (12) and tackles for loss (21) as a junior. He ranked 4th in the nation in sacks, 6th in TFLs.

Hart was named an All-American by the Associated Press, Walter Camp Foundation, Sporting News and the Sports Network.

### **WINNING SEASONS:**

The Bears recorded their fifth straight winning season last year, and their 29th in the last 33 years (dating back to 1976).

UCA tied the school record for wins three years ago (11-3) and finished 8-3 in both 2004 and 2006. They are a combined 43-16 over the past five seasons, three of those at the NCAA FCS level.

### **SCORING STREAK:**

The Bears have scored in 156 straight games, dating back to the 1995 season. UCA lost 19-0 at Delta State for their last shutout loss. The Bears have scored in 261 of their last 262 games, dating back to the 1986 season.

### **IN THE PROS:**

Former Bear All-American defensive end Jacob Ford is playing with the Tennessee Titans after being drafted in the sixth round (204th overall pick) in the 2007 draft. It was the highest round draft choice in UCA history, topping the 7th-round selection of receiver Tyree Davis in 1993.

Former UCA tight end Marquez Branson (2007-08) is in his first year with the Denver Broncos after an All-American career at UCA.

Former UCA cornerback/return specialist Tristan Jackson is in his second season in that same role for the Edmonton Eskimos.

### **OVER THE AIRWAVES:**

The UCA Radio Network returns for the third year in the capable hands of Steve Sullivan, Justin Acri and Monty Rowell.

Sullivan, the sports director at KATV, Channel 7 in Little Rock, will again handle the play by play of the remaining 11 UCA football games after missing out on the Hawaii trip. Justin Acri, the program director and midday talk show host at KABZ 103.7 The Buzz, will supply the color commentary

Monty Rowell, station manager at KUCA, will serve as the engineer and do the sideline reporting for the UCA broadcasts. The games will be carried live on KKPT The Point 94.1, based out of Little Rock. The games will also be carried by KUCA 91.3, Y107 in Greenbrier, KMTB 99.5 in Nashville/Murfreesboro, KDXE 1380 in Little Rock and KFFK 1390 in Rogers.
