COACHES:

CLINT CONQUE is in his 10th season at the helm of the UCA football program. He has a 73-38-0 overall record, including an 10-2 mark last season.

Conque, who came to UCA from Louisiana Tech in 2000, led the Bears to their first-ever NCAA Playoff appearance in 2001. UCA finished 9-3 that season, the most wins in a year since the 1992 season. He took them back to the playoffs in 2005, winning two straight road games and advancing to the national quarterfinals.



His Bears finished the 2008 season with the best record in the Southland Conference at 6-1 but were ineligible for the league title due to their transition. Conque was named the SLC Coach of the Year last season.

Conque, 48, is a Louisiana native who played collegiately at Nicholls State after graduating from Catholic High School in Baton Rouge and playing two years at Southwest Mississippi Junior College.

Conque was a first-team AP All-American as a outside linebacker at Nicholls State. He was inducted into the Nicholls State Athletic Hall of Fame in 2006.

His previous coaching stops were at Louisiana Tech, Samford University and McNeese State.

MIKE LUCAS is in his third season as the head coach of the Lions, with an overall record of 12-21.

Lucas served as SLU's defensive coordinator for two seasons before assuming the head coaching duties in December 2006. He was interim coach for the final three games of the 2006 season.

A 1982 graduate of Liberty University in Lynchburg, Va., Lucas coached previously at Sam Houston State, Eastern New Mexico, UTEP and his alma mater, Liberty.

THE SERIES:

This will be just the third meeting between the Bears and Lions, with UCA leading the series 2-0.

The Bears won the initial meeting in 2007, 37-33 in Hammond.

CONQUE CLIMBING:

Bears head coach Clint Conque, in his 10th season, has won 73 games at UCA, which places him second all-time at the school in career victories. He is only the second coach in school history to achieve the 70-victory plateau.

He now trails only Hall of Famer Harold Horton, who had a phenomenal 74-12-5 record from 1982-89.

NATIONAL RANKINGS:

UCA moved up two spots this week in the Coaches FCS Poll, from 14th to 12th. The Bears also moved up from 18th to 15th in The Sports Network poll.

UCA reached a high of 8th in the nation two weeks ago, the best regular-season ranking since moving to FCS in 2006.

The Bears were ranked anywhere from No. 8 to No. 16 in the various FCS preseason polls this fall.

The Bears were ranked as high as No. 9 in the nation during the 2008 season. They finished the season No. 12 in both polls.

LAST YEAR:

The Bears used a huge defensive play in the final minute last year, holding off the Lions 28-21 in Conway. SLU rallied with three second-half touchdowns and was driving for a tying score when UCA linebacker Vance Fizer knocked away a pass intended for Mike Neville.

UCA lost quarterback Nathan Brown to a slight concussion in the final minute of the first half. Before leaving, he led the Bears to a 21-0 lead, completing 13 of 23 for 156 yards. Robbie Park played the second half and led the Bears to their final touchdown, a 14-yard run by Brent Grimes midway through the third quarter.

Grimes rushed for 106 yards as the Bears amassed 382 yards of total offense. UCA had three players top the 1,000-yard receiving mark in the game in Eric Ware, Willie Landers and Marquez Branson.

LAST WEEK:

The UCA offense, led by senior running back Brent Grimes, put together its most solid effort of the season in downing Nicholls 42-13.

Grimes rushed for 155 yards on just 11 carries (14.1 ypc) and

scored three touchdowns on runs of 36, 18 and 42 yards. His average was the fourth-best in school history.

UCA rolled up a season-high 545 yards of offense and averaged 8.9 yards per carry. Senior QB Robbie Park completed touchdown passes to freshman Dominique Croom (35 yards) and senior James Lovett (42) and senior running back Leonard Ceaser added a 7-yard TD run. Placekicker Eddie Carmona was a perfect 6 of 6 on PATs.

UCA's defense held the Colonels to just 253 yards of total offense and recorded eight tackles behind the line.

SCORING MACHINE:

Senior tailback Brent Grimes led the Southland in scoring last season with a league-record 21 touchdowns and 126 points. The Baton Rouge native has picked up where he left off with 12 touchdowns in 7 games this season.

He leads the Southland in scoring, averaging 10.3 points per game.

Grimes is currently No. 2 on the all-time UCA list for touchdowns (52) and second in scoring (312 points). Former RB Kentrel Rogers holds both records with 53 TDs and 322 points.

Grimes tied the school record with 5 TDs against Stephen F. Austin last season. In that game, he had career highs of 36 carries and 145 yards, and also had a career-high 8 receptions in the Bears' 49-41 victory.

L.B. JACKMAN AWARD:

Grimes was named the winner of the annual L.B. Jackman Award as outstanding player of the homecoming game. The award is voted on by the working media at the game.

It was Grimes' second time to win the award, to go along with his honor as a freshman. In that game, Grimes rushed 12 times for 116 yards and two touchdowns in UCA's 55-21 win over Southern Arkansas

He is only the fifth player to win the award more than once, joining Bobby Tiner (1963, 66, 67), Mike Painter (1975, 77), Phil Caldwell (1980, 81) and Ken Collums (1991, 94).

PLAYERS OF THE GAME:

The weekly "Player of the Game" awards, handed out by the UCA coaching staff, went to the entire line on offense, to linebacker Jacob Bane on defense and to punter Jon Beard on special teams. The "Big Stick" award went to LB Tok Opeloye.

BEHIND THE LINE:

The Bears have had 37 different players record at least one tackle this season. The amazing number is 27 different players have been in on a tackle for loss.

UCA has recorded 58 lost-yardage plays for a minus 225 yards. Included in that number is 17 sacks for minus 118 yards.

The leader in tackles for loss is senior linebacker Jacob Bane with 8 (-22). Junior DE Markell Carter is next at 7 (-42). The sack leader is senior DE Larry Hart with 6 (-43).

UCA has recorded only four interceptions in seven games (Hart, James Lancaster, Pieri Feazell, Derrick Boyd). UCA has also forced 13 turnovers in seven games (four

HOMECOMING GAMES:

The Bears improved to 53-26-1 in Homecoming games with the win over Nicholls. UCA has now won seven consecutive homecoming games, dating back to 2003, and eight of the past nine.

HOME LOSS:

The loss two weeks ago to SFA was the first at home for the Bears since they lost to South Dakota State on Nov. 3, 2007. It broke a 10-game home winning streak. It was UCA's first home conference loss since Valdosta State on Sept. 25, 2004.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK:

UCA has had five players named Southland Conference Player of the Week this year. They include:
 Junior kicker Eddie Carmona against Northwestern State; senior safety Derrick Boyd against Missouri S&T; senior safety Pieri Feazell against Hawaii; senior quarterback Robbie Park and senior linebacker James Lancaster against Western Kentucky.

NATIONAL FCS RANKINGS:

The Bears are ranked third in the nation in tackles for loss (58), fourth in kick returns (25.7), tied for fourth in sacks allowed (5), tied for seventh in scoring defense (14.0 ppg), seventh in pass efficiency (154.46) and 11th in punt returns (13.6).
 Individuals ranked in the Top 10 include: Larry Hart third in forced fumbles and tied for 14th in sacks; Isaiah Jackson sixth in punt returns and tied for 12th in kick returns; Robbie Park seventh in pass efficiency, and Brent Grimes third in scoring and 26th in rushing.

PERFECT EDDIE:

Eddie Carmona has been perfect this season as a placekicker. The Charleston kicker has made 7 of 7 field goal attempts and 28 of 28 extra points. His long field goal is 38 yards twice (vs. SFA and Glenville State).
 He has tied the school record with nine consecutive field goals, alongside UCA Sports Hall of Famer Curtis Burrow.
 A year ago in his first season at UCA, Carmona was 13 of 19 on field goals and 53 of 57 on PATs.

vs. THE SOUTHLAND:

Since joining the Southland Conference in 2006, UCA has put together a stellar 15-4 record.

The lone losses have come to McNeese State and Northwestern State in 2007, Nicholls State last season and to SFA two weeks ago. The first three of those losses were on the road. UCA is 8-1 at home in Southland play.

ADD GRIMES:

Grimes is just 58 receiving yards short of becoming the first player in UCA history to rush for more than 2,000 yards and catch passes for 1,000 yards.
 He stands at 2,427 career rushing yards (10th in school history) and now has 942 receiving yards.

UCA vs. FBS:

UCA, in its fourth season at the FCS (playoff) level, won its first game over an FBS school on Sept. 19, knocking off Western Kentucky 28-7 on the road in Bowling Green, Ky.
 The Bears were 0-5 against FBS teams, including losses to Arkansas State in 1996 and 1997, to Louisiana Tech in 2007, to Tulsa in 2008 and to Hawaii in the 2009 season opener.
 For the first time in school history, the Bears played two FBS teams in the same season and it just happened to be the first two games of the season.

PASSING FANCY:

Fifteen different players have caught passes for UCA, including starting quarterback Robbie Park. Five players have double-figure catches, including senior James Lovett (27), senior Preston Echols (25), junior Darrius McNeal (17), senior Brent Grimes (14) and senior Leonard Ceaser (11). Nine different players have caught touchdown passes.
 UCA is completing 67.7 percent of its passes compared to 54.8 for its opponents.

TV TIME:

The Bears had their perfect television record over the past

past nine years broken in the season opener with the loss at Hawaii. Prior to that, UCA had won nine consecutive televised games, including wins over Sam Houston and McNeese State a year ago. During the Conque era, beginning in 2000, the Bears are now 9-2 in TV games after the loss to SFA

UCA will return to TV next week when it hosts Texas State.

PARK PLACE:

Fifth-year senior Robbie Park, who took over this season for record-setting quarterback Nathan Brown, has been efficient in seven starts this season.

Park, who started three games over the course of his career when Brown was injured, has completed 124 of 183 passes (67.8 percent) for 1,542 yards. He has 12 touchdown passes and 3 interceptions and an efficiency rating of 154.46.

Against Western Kentucky, Park completed 18 of 21 passes, with the other three passes dropped. Against Glenville State, he threw for a career-high 358 yards.

NEW FACES:

Four players for the Bears scored their first career touchdowns three weeks ago in the 34-0 win over Northwestern State.

Freshman receiver Dominique Croom and sophomore receiver Isaiah Jackson caught touchdown passes, while redshirt freshman receiver Jackie Hinton Jr., had a 48-yard touchdown run. QB Robbie Park caught his first touchdown pass from Brent Grimes.

In all, 12 different players have scored for the Bears, led by Grimes with 72 points.

HALL OF FAME:

UCA inducted 10 new members into its Sports Hall of Fame last month, including Charlie Strong, University of Florida defensive coordinator/associate head coach for the No. 1 Florida Gators. Strong played defensive back at UCA from 1978-81.

IN THE RED:

The Bears are No. 1 in the Southland Conference in red-zone defense. UCA has allowed opponent scores on only 13 of 20 trips into the red zone (65 percent).

UCA also leads the league in scoring defense (14.0 ppg), pass defense (185.4), kickoff returns (25.7), punt returns (13.6), kickoff coverage, field goals (1.000), PAT kicking (1.000), sacks against (0.71) and opponent first downs (16.0).

REIGNING "CHAMPS":

The Bears "won" the Southland Conference title last season, at least on the field. UCA finished with a league-best 6-1 record, besting second-place Texas State (5-2) and McNeese State and Northwestern State, both at 4-3.

However, the Bears were not eligible to be named conference champions because of their transition, according to an NCAA ruling handed down with two weeks remaining in the season.

According to the NCAA, if the Southland were to allow UCA to be crowned league champion, the conference would lose its automatic qualifier for the playoffs.

UCA is in the fourth year of its four-year transition from NCAA Division II to Division I FCS and is ineligible for postseason play until 2010.

The title of conference champion and the automatic qualifier went to Texas State (5-2 in league play), which lost 31-13 to Montana in the first round of the playoffs.

The Bears' last official conference championship was won in 2005 at the NCAA Division II level when they took the Gulf South Conference championship.

HOME RECORD:

Over the past five seasons, the Bears are 27-4 at home at First Security Field at Estes Stadium, including 7-0 last season.

The lone losses were to South Dakota State in 2007, North Alabama in the NCAA Division II playoff quarterfinals in 2005, to Valdosta State in 2004 and to SFA two weeks ago.

UCA went 4-1 in 2007 at Estes, was 4-0 in 2006, went 5-1 in 2005 (5-0 in the regular season) and had a 4-1 mark in 2004.

The Bears are 3-1 at home this season.

ESTES CROWDS:

The Bears have played to record crowds in recent years at First Security Field at Estes Stadium. Four of UCA's Top 10 home crowds of all time came last season.

UCA drew 12,313 for the Sam Houston State game (2nd ranked), 12,158 for the Henderson State game (3rd), 10,873 for the Quincy game (5th) and 10,220 for the McNeese State game (10th).

The largest crowd in school history was 12,620 vs. Nicholls State on Nov. 3, 2007.

Last week's homecoming crowd of 10,653 was the ninth largest in history. The Missouri S&T game on Oct. 3 drew 10,443, the 10th largest crowd in school history. UCA students were on fall break against SFA and the game drew 7,527 fans.

AWARD WINNERS:

UCA captured three of the six postseason individual awards handed out by the Southland Conference last fall.

Head Coach Clint Conque was the SLC Coach of the Year, while senior quarterback Nathan Brown was the SLC Player of the Year.

The SLC Defensive Player of the Year award went to UCA junior defensive end Larry Hart, who returns for his senior season as a much-decorated All-American.

The Bears had seven first-team All-SLC selections a year ago, six second-teamers and three honorable mentions.

MISSING IN ACTION:

The Bears are missing two of those All-SLC players. Junior receiver Willie Landers injured a knee on the first day of practice in August and had ACL surgery. Senior fullback Nick Cowger injured his knee before the opener and will also miss the 2009 season.

SOUTHLAND TV:

SLC TV is back this year with 11 live football broadcasts, along with 16 basketball games, and championships of the soccer, volleyball, softball and baseball tournaments.

UCA's home games with Stephen F. Austin (Oct. 17) and Texas State (Nov. 7) will be broadcast live from First Security Field at Estes Stadium.

The affiliates showing the SLC package include: KARZ in Little Rock, KFDM television and Time Warner Cable in Beaumont, TX, KTBU in Houston, WBTR in Baton Rouge, La., KPXJ in Shreveport, La., KWCE in Alexandria, La., KVHP in Lake Charles, La., and MYTX in Tyler, Texas.

SLC TELECONFERENCE:

The Southland Conference hosts a weekly teleconference with the football coaches at 10:30 a.m. each Tuesday.

Coach Clint Conque is the first coach to take questions each week, beginning at approximately 10:35. Todd Lamb of the SLC recaps the weekly highlights and previews the upcoming games beginning at 10:30. The teleconferences will run on www.ucasports.com as well as on www.southland.org.

DIRTY DOZEN:

The Bears will be the only FCS team to play 12 regular-season games this season, because of the trip to Hawaii.

UCA played 12 regular-season games for the first time ever a year ago and will now face a dozen opponents for the second straight year. Beginning last Saturday, the Bears will play on 11 consecutive weekends with no break.

GOTTA HAVE HART:

Senior defensive end Larry Hart was an All-American a year ago, as well as the Southland Defensive Player of the Year. He finished seventh in the voting for the 2008 Buck Buchanan Award that goes to the nation's top FCS defensive player. He is on the 2009 watch list for the award.

Hart, who transferred in last year from Holmes Community college, led the Southland in sacks (12) and tackles for loss (21) as a junior. He ranked 4th in the nation in sacks, 6th in TFLs.

Hart was named an All-American by the Associated Press, Walter Camp Foundation, Sporting News and the Sports Network.

WINNING SEASONS:

The Bears recorded their fifth straight winning season last year, and their 29th in the last 33 years (dating back to 1976).

UCA tied the school record for wins three years ago (11-3) and finished 8-3 in both 2004 and 2006. They are a combined 43-16 over the past five seasons, three of those at the NCAA FCS level.

SCORING STREAK:

The Bears have scored in 155 straight games, dating back to the 1995 season. UCA lost 19-0 at Delta State for their last shutout loss. The Bears have scored in 260 of their last 261 games, dating back to the 1986 season.

IN THE PROS:

Former Bear All-American defensive end Jacob Ford is playing

with the Tennessee Titans after being drafted in the sixth round (204th overall pick) in the 2007 draft. It was the highest round draft choice in UCA history, topping the 7th-round selection of receiver Tyree Davis in 1993.

Former UCA tight end Marquez Branson (2007-08) is in his first year with the Denver Broncos after an All-American career at UCA.

Former UCA cornerback/return specialist Tristan Jackson is in his second season in that same role for the Edmonton Eskimos.

OVER THE AIRWAVES:

The UCA Radio Network returns for the third year in the capable hands of Steve Sullivan, Justin Acri and Monty Rowell.

Sullivan, the sports director at KATV, Channel 7 in Little Rock, will again handle the play by play of the remaining 11 UCA football games after missing out on the Hawaii trip. Justin Acri, the program director and midday talk show host at KABZ 103.7 The Buzz, will supply the color commentary

Monty Rowell, station manager at KUCA, will serve as the engineer and do the sideline reporting for the UCA broadcasts. The games will be carried live on KKPT The Point 94.1, based out of Little Rock. The games will also be carried by KUCA 91.3, Y107 in Greenbrier, KMTB 99.5 in Nashville/Murfreesboro, KDXE 1380 in Little Rock and KFFK 1390 in Rogers. They will be live on www.ucasports.com.

CALLING COACH CONQUE:

For the third consecutive year, UCA head coach Clint Conque and statewide radio personality Justin Acri will host a live call-in show every Thursday night from Doe's Eat Place in downtown Conway.

Acri is the color commentator for Bears' radio broadcasts and the program director at The Buzz 103.7. Acri also hosts the UCA Football Report, the weekly coach's show that runs on KATV, the ABC affiliate in Little Rock at 11:30 p.m. Sundays.

Acri and Conque will answer questions each Thursday from 7 to 8 p.m. from the live audience at Doe's and also field calls from fans (433-1037 or 1-800-477-1037).

POSTSEASON HISTORY:

The Bears made their second appearance in the NCAA Division II Playoffs in 2005, advancing to the quarterfinals before losing to North Alabama 41-38 in overtime at Estes Stadium.

UCA won its first two playoff games on the road, beating Albany (Ga.) State 28-20 and blasting fifth-ranked Presbyterian College 52-28 in Clinton, S.C. UCA's other D-II playoff appearance was in 2001, when it lost 35-34 to Catawba College in Salisbury, S.C.

The Bears will not be eligible for postseason play until 2010 because of the transition period to NCAA Division I.

Back in the NAIA days, the Bears were perennial playoff teams, winning three national championships in 1984, 1985 and 1991. UCA moved up to Division II in 1993 and to FCS in 2006.

500 AND COUNTING:

The victory over Quincy last September was win No. 500 for the Bears in the 100-year history of the program. UCA's all-time record is 512-350-42.
