Overview

Southeastern Louisiana University looks to rebound from a disappointing one-point loss at nationally-ranked McNeese State today when it faces Southland Conference rival Central Arkansas.

Today's game begins a stretch where Southeastern will play three of its final four games at home. The Lions, who are off to their best start in Southland Conference play, will host Stephen F. Austin (Nov. 14) and in-state rival Nicholls State (Nov. 19) with their lone road game set for Nov. 7 at Northwestern State.

Southeastern has shown the ability to come back from deficits on the road, rallying from a 44-20 deficit to defeat Texas State and scoring 28 straight points last week at McNeese State in erasing a 24-7 deficit.

The Lions enter the game ranked No. 5 among FCS schools in scoring offense (36.0) and No. 8 in passing offense (.286.86). Brian Babin, who is second in the majority of Southeastern's career passing records, has thrown for 1,879 yards and 19 touchdowns in seven games.

Simmie Yarborough, who needs one reception to become the sixth player in school history to record 100, has caught 48 passes with 11 touchdowns on the season.

Sporting the Southland Conference's fourth-best offense, Southeastern will face a rugged UCA defense that leads the league in total defense and is led by Buck Buchanan Award List member Larry Hart.

Head Coach Mike Lucas

Entering his third season as head football coach at Southeastern Louisiana University, Mike Lucas has continued to strive on a mission of molding a championship-caliber program through a heavy emphasis on in-state recruiting.

Named the 14th head football coach in Southeastern Louisiana history on December 14, 2006, his main focus was to quickly stabilize a young program that was affected by two seasons of distractions while building a program with new players from a deep pool of talent in the state of Louisiana.

One look at the Southeastern roster reveals a strong base of players from the Pelican State. Of the players on the 2009 roster, 63 hail from the state of Louisiana with 45 players signed from in-state within the past three classes.

But with his many years of experience in the Southland Conference, learning under some of the league's legendary mentors, and gaining the trust and admiration of his players, Lucas has the Lions back on track as they enter their fifth season in one of the top football conferences in the Football Championship Subdivision.

Despite missing half of the 2008 season to undergo a heart valve procedure, Lucas' leadership was evident from the moment he had to temporarily step away. His first decision was to name offensive coordinator Tommy Condell as acting head coach – a move that helped the program remain stable. The Lions finished the 2008 campaign with a 5-7 record, their best mark since a 7-4 mark in 2004, and were competitive in each game of a 12-game schedule that included SEC opponent Mississippi State and in-state rival Louisiana Tech.

In 2008, Southeastern posted the third-best mark in school history for passing yards (3,087), all-purpose yards (5,702), total offense (4,088) and points scored (327). Quarterback Brian Babin posted the third-best totals for passing yards (2,806), touchdowns (25) and completion percentage (62.4) while three receivers – Jay Lucas, Chris Wilson and SLC Freshman-of-the-Year Simmie Yarborough – each caught 50 passes in a season.

Defensively, safety Tommy Connors produced an All-American season, finishing second in the Southland Conference in tackles while leading the league in interceptions.

Officially named head football coach at the end of the 2006 campaign after serving the previous two seasons as defensive coordinator, Lucas is familiar with the ingredients that are needed to be a consistent winner in the Southland Conference.

Lucas took over the program on an interim basis for the final three games of the 2006 season before embarking on his first full season as head coach in 2007. With a new quarterback and tremendous youth on the defensive side of the ball, the Lions showed dramatic improvement

and played with the heart and determination needed to win championships.

Southeastern finished the 2007 season with a 3-8 record, but the foundation for a successful gridiron future was laid under Lucas' guidance.

Offensively in 2007, Southeastern relied on the play of All-SLC running back Jay Lucas along with first-year starter Babin, who made great strides during the season at quarterback and fifth-year wideout Byron Ross, who provided the Lions on of the top deep threats in the league.

With an extremely youthful defense, featuring as many as seven true freshmen on the field at one time, Southeastern displayed Lucas' hard-nosed style of play in every game during the season.

With a defense highlighted by a pair of youngsters, Connors and freshman linebacker Mark Newbill, the Lions finished near the top of the FCS national rankings in turnover margin.

Under Lucas' guidance as Southeastern entered the SLC in 2005 after spending the previous two years as an independent, the majority of the Lions' defensive numbers improved across the board despite facing a much stiffer schedule including a full-conference slate. As newcomers to the SLC, the Lions were no cubs, especially on defense where they were third overall, behind only conference co-champs Nicholls and Texas State, in total defense (349.5 YPG), were second in pass efficiency defense (115.7), third in rushing defense (146.3 YPG) and first in opponent first downs allowed (181).

Following the season, defensive back Charles Hall signed a free agent contract with the Cleveland Browns pushing the total number of defensive NFL signees coached by Lucas to eight. Six Lion defenders earned all-Southland notice while Duriel Adams was also named all-Louisiana.

Lucas also serves as the liaison to the Career and Academic Planning Center. The CAP Center assists with all advising and tutorial services provided for Southeastern student-athletes. After one year, the team G.P.A. had seen a considerable increase, doubling the number of football players attaining a 3.0.

Although the hard work of the players, coaches and staff are critical, at least part of the Lions' success in 2005 could be attributed to Lucas' familiarity with the Southland. No stranger to the SLC, Lucas previously served as defensive coordinator and assistant head coach for veteran Ron Randleman at Sam Houston State for 15 years repeatedly producing defensive units that ranked among the best in NCAA Division I-AA football and the Southland Conference.

During his time at SHSU, Lucas guided the Bearkat defense among the top 15 in national defensive statistical categories 11 times and led the Southland in defensive statistics five times. The defense set several school records in his tenure including marks for most quarterback sacks (52, 2001) and fewest points allowed (13.2 ppg, 1991). Under Lucas, the Bearkat defense turned out seven defensive players who signed National Football League contracts and two who were NFL draft choices.

Lucas coached 41 defensive players who earned All-Southland honors a total of 65 times. Prior to joining the SHSU staff in 1987, Lucas previously served as defensive coordinator at Eastern New Mexico where his squad led the Lone Star Conference in total defense and scoring defense and ranked third nationally in punt returns.

In 1984, he coached wide receivers at UTEP. From 1980 to 1983, he coached the secondary, defensive line and linebackers and assisted in the strength and conditioning program at Liberty University in Lynchburg, Va. He began his coaching career at the College of William and Mary in 1979 as a defensive student assistant.

Lucas was a three-year letterman in football at Pemberton (N.J.) High School and also lettered in baseball and wrestling. He earned a Bachelor of Science degree from Liberty in 1982, majoring in physical education and psychology.

He and his wife, Wendy, have two sons, Tyler (22), a former quarterback and 2009 graduate of Cornell University, and Torin (20), a sophomore catcher on the Southeastern baseball team.

Lucas Makes A Triumphant Return To The Sideline

Southeastern Louisiana head coach Mike Lucas made a successful return to the sideline in the Lions' Sept. 5 opener against Texas A&M-Commerce after missing the final six games last season due to a heart valve procedure. Lucas was forced to leave the team on Oct. 15 and underwent the procedure Oct. 30 at the prestigious Cleveland Clinic.

Lucas made a surprise appearance at the end of practice on Nov. 6, participated in Senior Day activities on Nov. 8 and coached from the press box in the Lions' season-finale at arch-rival Nicholls State.

Connors To Miss Remainder Of 2009 Season

Southeastern Louisiana defensive back Tommy Connors was evaluated by team doctors for his injured right thumb sustained at No. 5-ranked Ole Miss on Sept. 19.

Connors, a Buck Buchanan Watch List candidate and 2008 All-America selection, underwent surgery on Sept. 23 after an evaluation on Oct. 21, will miss the remainder of the 2009 season.

Three Lions Named To Preseason All-Southland Team

Southeastern's Tommy Connors, Jeff Turner and Simmie Yarborough represented the Lions on the 2009 Preseason All-Southland Conference Football Teams, which were announced on July 29 in conjunction with the league's Media Days at the L'auberge du Lac Resort.

Connors, a Marrero native, Turner, who hails from Houston, Texas and Yarborough, a Brookhaven, Miss., product were each named to the first team.

The preseason honor was just the latest for Connors, a Buck Buchanan Award nominee – presented to the top defensive player in the Division I Football Championship Subdivision (FCS). A consensus preseason All-America selection, Connors is coming off a banner 2008 season. Connors led the Southland Conference with four interceptions and posted 108 tackles – the most by a Lion since the program's return in 2003.

Connors was heavily honored following his breakout junior season, earning All-America honors from the Sports Network, Associated Press and College Sporting News. A first team All-Southland and All-Louisiana selection in 2008, the accounting major was a strong performer in the classroom, claiming Southland Conference All-Academic honors for the second straight season. Connors is tied atop the school's career list with three fumble recoveries and is fifth with 251 career tackles.

Turner gives the Lions one of FCS' premier kickers. Last season, Turner connected on 12 of 17 field goal attempts. The Cypress Creek High School alum was an honorable mention Sports Network All-America pick as a sophomore, connecting on 17 of 20 field goals. The school's career leader with 36 field goals made and a 76.6 percent conversion rate, Turner needs 17 points, seven extra-points and 11 field goal attempts to become the Lion standard bearer in each of those categories.

While Connors and Turner provide the Lions with veteran experience, Yarborough will look to duplicate his 2008 season, in which he made an immediate impact on the way to being named Freshman of the Year by the Southland and the Louisiana Sports Writers Association. In 11 games, Yarborough collected 51 passes for 490 yards and six touchdowns in his debut campaign. His reception total represented the fourth-highest single-season total in school history, while his touchdown total was the sixth-highest by a Lion.

Lions Picked Seventh, Eighth In Southland Preseason Poll

Looking to build off a 5-7 season that features the return of 15 starters, Southeastern Louisiana will look to play the role of spoiler as the Southland Conference released its 2009 Preseason Polls, which were announced July 29 in conjunction with the league's Media Days at the L'Auberge du Lac Resort.

The Lions, who open their season tonight against Texas A&M-Commerce, were picked to finish seventh by the league's sports information directors and eighth in the head coaches poll. Southeastern, which returns 40 letterwinners for

third-year coach Mike Lucas, edged in-state rival Nicholls in the SID poll while narrowly were edged in the Coaches' Poll.

Defending champion Texas State was picked to repeat in both polls followed by perennial FCS power McNeese State. The Bobcats garnered 43 points and two first-place votes among the eight coaches while MSU tallied 39 points and a first-place vote.

Northwestern State (38 points, 2 first-place votes) was picked to finish third in the Coaches' Poll followed by Central Arkansas (37), Stephen F. Austin (24), Sam Houston State (17), Nicholls (14) and Southeastern (13).

In the SID poll, Texas State earned five first-place votes and gained 45 points. McNeese State was second with 43 points followed by UCA (38), Northwestern State (26), SFA (20), SHSU (19), Southeastern (18) and Nicholls (15).

Turner Getting His Kicks In

With every kicking record in hand, Jeff Turner continues to add to his stellar career after becoming the Lions' all-time leading scorer in a 69-20 win over Union College.

Turner surpassed the previous record of 202 points set by Southeastern Hall of Famer Horace Belton with his fourth extra point of the Sept. 10 game. In his career that included honorable mention All-America notice in 2007, Turner has scored 242 points.

Turner, who holds the Southeastern and Southland Conference single-game record with six field goals (against Texas State in 2007), has made seven of his last nine attempts and is 9-for-14 on the season and 27-for-29 in extra points.

Babin, Connors Earn Preseason FCS All-America Honors

Southeastern Louisiana University football players Tommy Connors and Brian Babin each received 2009 Division I Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) preseason All-America recognition from Consensus Draft Services.

Connors (Marrero, La.), a senior defensive back, was a second-team selection while Babin (St. Amant, La.) was tabbed as honorable mention at quarterback. Connors and Babin were among 12 Southland Conference student-athletes named to the team.

Connors led Southeastern and was second in the Southland Conference with 108 tackles while leading the league with four interceptions. The three-time All-Southland Conference standout and former Archbishop Shaw product earned All-America honors by the Associated Press and the Sports Network. Connors posted four games with 10 or more tackles, highlighted by a 15-tackle performance at nationally-ranked Central Arkansas.

Babin recorded 2,806 yards passing with 25 touchdowns last season in directing the Southeastern offense. The former St. Amant High product, completed 62 percent (257-for-412) of his passes with seven interceptions while posting 300-plus passing games against South Dakota (330 yards) and Louisiana Tech (322).

Six Southeastern Games Slated For Television

With four Southeastern Louisiana University football games already slated for television in the 2009 season, the University's educational cable access channel – The Southeastern Channel – announced that it will televise two home games on a tape-delayed basis.

Southeastern's contests against Southland Conference rivals Sam Houston State (Oct. 17) and Stephen F. Austin (Nov. 14) will be televised on Charter Cable (Channel 18 in Tangipahoa, St. Tammany and Livingston Parish and Channel 17 in Washington Parish).

The games will air during the week following the game at 7:30 p.m. on Thursday, 2:30 p.m. on Friday, 7:30 a.m. on Saturday and 1 p.m. on Sunday.

The games will also be available on the Southeastern Channel's website at www.selu.edu/tv. Southeastern graduates Chris Coleman and Allen Waddell will handle the play-by-play and color, respectively.

The Southland Conference announced last month at its Football Media Day that a pair of league games – at McNeese State (Oct. 24) and at home against Nicholls State (Nov. 19) – were slated for a regional broadcast on the Southland

Zach Albin added a block in the Lions' season-opener against Texas A&M-Commerce while Stephen Moreaux got a critical block in fourth quarter of the Lions' dramatic comeback win at Texas State on Oct. 10.

Lions, UT-Martin To Open Two-Game Series Beginning In 2010

The Southeastern Louisiana University Department of Athletics and head football coach Mike Lucas announced that it has signed a home-and-home agreement to play the University of Tennessee at Martin beginning in the 2010 season.

Southeastern and UTM, which were rivals in the Gulf South Conference from 1974-76, will open the series on Sept. 11, 2010 in Strawberry Stadium. The Lions will return the trip to UTM, a member of the Ohio Valley Conference, in a Sept. 3, 2011 contest at Hardy M. Graham Stadium.

Southeastern and UTM last faced each other in football in 1981 with the Lions claiming a 13-10 homecoming victory. Southeastern, which leads the series 3-1, claimed a pair of wins in Hammond in 1974 and 1976 under former coach Billy Brewer while UTM claimed a 23-7 victory in 1975 - the only game played in Martin.

The addition of UTM will give Southeastern five games on its 2010 home schedule. The Lions will also face first-year program Lamar (Sept. 18) in another FCS non-conference game before hosting Southland Conference rivals Texas State (Oct. 2), McNeese State (Oct. 16) and Northwestern State (Oct. 30).

Lions Against FBS (Former I-A) Opponents

Southeastern has kept up its tradition of taking on the Big Boys as it faced Football Bowl Subdivision (formerly I-A) opponents Mississippi State and Louisiana Tech in 2008 ... Southeastern faced three FBS schools in 2007, falling at New Mexico State (35-14), Orange Bowl champion Kansas (62-0) and Tulane (35-27) ... Since the program's resurrection, Southeastern has played 11 games (going 0-11) against the top level of college football beginning with a 28-0 loss at Troy in 2003 ... Two years later, Southeastern tangled with Tulane (playing its 11 games in 11 different stadiums after the damage caused by Hurricane Katrina) in LSU's Tiger Stadium and lost a narrow decision, 28-21, before dropping games to NMSU (30-15), Southern Miss (45-0) and Texas Tech (62-0) in 2006.

Last Time Out (McNeese State 36, Southeastern 35)

Derrick Fourroux's 5-yard touchdown pass to Richard Connor with 39.7 seconds remaining helped No. 11 McNeese State rally from an 11-point deficit and edge Southeastern Louisiana, 36-35, in a wild Southland Conference game Saturday night at Cowboy Stadium.

Fourroux, who went 21-for-36 for 268 yards and a pair of touchdowns, added a 20-yard scoring run as McNeese State (5-2, 2-1 Southland) built a 24-7 lead with 1:44 remaining in the first half.

Southeastern (4-3, 2-1 Southland) cut the lead to 24-14 at halftime on a Chris Wilson 4-yard touchdown pass from Brian Babin before a 21-point outburst in the third quarter gave the Lions a 35-24 lead.

Babin, who went 23-for-37 for 250 yards, cut the lead to 24-21 on a 1-yard sneak with 12:58 remaining in the third quarter. Wesley Ladner then blocked a punt that Clint Coleman returned to the McNeese 1, and Zeke Jones scored on the following play to give Southeastern its first lead of the game at 28-24.

After Ladner recovered a muffed punt return by Champlain Babin at the McNeese 33, the Lions needed six plays to reach the end zone as Babin connected with Wilson on a 3-yard pass with 4:28 left in the third quarter.

The Lions had a chance to put the game away with a 35-30 lead in the fourth when Avery Crooks recovered another fumble by Champlain Babin at the SLU 39 and the Lions drove to the McNeese State 22. Jeff Turner missed a 38-yard field goal attempt with 3:18, and McNeese State had another opportunity to score.

McNeese State built a 17-0 lead early in the second quarter as Josh Lewis booted a 43-yard field goal on the Cowboys' opening possession. After Jeremy Pilate forced a Southeastern fumble after the Lions reached the McNeese 2, the Cowboys drove 67 yards in two plays for a 10-0 lead.

Champlain Babin, who rushed for 67 yards on 13 carries, gained 27 yards around right end before Fourroux hit a wide-open Corday Clark for a 40-yard TD strike for a 10-0 lead with 4:54 remaining in the first quarter.

Mark Newbill led Southeastern with 13 tackles while Ryan Godare had six stops and Brian Reynolds five with a pair of sacks. Both teams forced four turnovers with the Cowboys picking off three Babin passes.

On All-Time Openers

Southeastern has a 37-21-3 record in season-opening games dating back to 1930 ... The Lions have won their last two openers after dropping contests in 2006 and 2007 at FBS member New Mexico State ... the Lions won their first three after reviving the program in 2003 ... in road openers dating back to 1946, Southeastern has posted an 12-9-1 record ... prior to its win last season in Lorman, the Lions' last victory to open the season on the road came at McNeese State (17-7) in 1982.

Perfect In Home Openers Since Return

Since returning football to campus in the 2003 season, Southeastern has been perfect in season-opening games at home going 7-0 ... the Lions, who defeated South Dakota, 31-30, in last year's opener, earned wins over Division II Arkansas-Monticello in 2003 (22-17) and 2004 (46-32) before picking up a win over Alcorn State (48-21) in the 2005 debut ... in 2006, Southeastern defeated Jacksonville (Fla.), 41-13, and blasted Division II Kentucky Wesleyan, 79-7, in last season's home opener ... since its 2003 win over UAM, Southeastern has averaged 44.0 points per game as it has outscored its opponents, 308-110.

Pitching The Shutout

Since the program's return in 2003 after an 18-year hiatus, Southeastern has come close numerous times in recording a shutout without success so far. The last time Southeastern pitched a shutout came on Sept. 29, 1984 when the Lions blanked Western Kentucky, 28-0, in Strawberry Stadium - a span of 93 games.

Welcome To College Football

A total of 25 Southeastern players saw their first collegiate football action when the Lions hosted Texas A&M-Commerce on Sept. 5. Five players, including four on defense, earned starts in the contest. Through the first five games, a total of seven true freshmen (Beau Mothe, Sam Fairley, Jordan McClay, Tay Alford, Morgan Scala, Greg Johnson) have seen action with Will Kelly making his debut in the Lions' Southland Conference opener at Texas State.

The Last Meeting (UCA 28, SLU 21 • Oct. 25, 2008 • Conway, Ark.)

The Southeastern Louisiana football team's rally from a 28-point deficit fell just short, as the Lions dropped a 28-21 decision at No. 13 Central Arkansas in Southland Conference action Saturday afternoon at Estes Stadium.

Southeastern got the ball back with just under three minutes to play and a chance to drive down and tie the game. However, UCA's defense stiffened and held Southeastern without a first down. On fourth-and-14, Vance Fizer broke up Brian Babin's pass attempt, allowing UCA to regain possession and run out the clock.

Southeastern (4-4, 1-2 SLC) fell into a 28-0 hole, thanks in large part to a season-high 15 penalties for 97 yards. UCA took over sole possession of first place in the Southland Conference standings, improving to 7-1 overall and a perfect 3-0 in league play.

After a lackluster first half, Babin bounced back and completed 27-for-43 passes for 270 yards, three touchdowns and an interception. Southeastern running back Jay Lucas had 111 total yards and a touchdown. Simmie Yarborough (9-75) and Chris Wilson (5-63) each caught touchdown passes for the Lions. Defensively, Tommy Connors led the Lions with 15 tackles, while Mark Newbill made 12 stops for Southeastern.

UCA quarterback Nathan Brown finished 13-of-23 for 156 yards and two touchdowns, suffering a concussion late in the first half and not returning. The Bears were led by Brent Grimes, who rushed for 21 carries for 106 yards and two touchdowns, while catching a touchdown score as well.
